What is Home Support?

The East Radnor Home Support is a service run by East Radnorshire Care and is funded by Powys County Council.

The service is available to anyone aged 50+ living in Presteigne, Knighton and the wider communities encompassing surrounding villages approximately 12 miles from Presteigne. However, to qualify for the service you must live in Powys.

Home Support is not a care agency but offers low level practical everyday assistance to enable people to retain their independence.

Once registered you can use the services as little or as often as you need. We can offer one off help such as form filling or support following a hospital stay or more regular assistance such as welfare monitoring and support.

All staff are fully trained and DBS checked.

Our Services

- ♦ 24/7 Rapid Response via Lifeline alarms
- ♦ Welfare monitoring
- ♦ Meals on Wheels Lunch delivery daily Monday to Friday
- ♦ Assistance with prescriptions
- ♦ Emergency shopping
- ♦ Assistance to complete forms, letters, paperwork, etc.
- ♦ Support in emergency situations
- ♦ Help with making appointments
- ♦ Signposting and easy access to other services
- ♦ Lunch Club every Monday and Thursday transport available
- ♦ Bathing by appointment
- ♦ Benefit Checks

Many services are **free of charge**, but a small charge is made for meals & bathing.

It is free to become a member and once joined you can use services as little or as often as you need.

We can help you with one off form filling for example or arranging an appointment. Alternatively we offer regular ongoing support.

We are a small friendly team, offering bespoke services tailored to your individual needs. The team is made up of both on call staff and support staff who are based at the office in Presteigne and are available Monday-Friday 9am-5pm.

The on call staff are available in emergency situations.
