The Restart Scheme provides you with a personal Job Coach who will meet with you regularly and provide telephone, online and face to face support, to:

- ➔ Identify and encourage your work goals and help you to transfer your existing skills into your next role
- ➔ Develop a plan to help you find new employment, and provide local work experience placements and skills training
- ➔ Detail how your benefit calculations will look once you are in work and as you earn more
- ➔ Advise you on how to manage your money, child/caring responsibilities, housing and/or travel costs whilst on the scheme. We can fund reasonable costs associated with your participation on the Restart Scheme
- ➔ Signpost you to local health and wellbeing organisations which can support you as you re-enter the workforce if needed
